




Do you rely on a high school student/child to provide care for your elementary/middle schoolaged child?

  - Operating budget up to \$70,000 loss (enterprise fund)
  - Field availability to community groups (i.e. LUSC, Pop Warner, Babe Ruth, youth lacrosse)
  - Building availability (i.e. gyms); depends on level
  - Recreation Committee/Department involvement (i.e. five year capital plan)
- METCO
- Transportation implications
  - Transportation model options
  - Non-LPS after-school transportation
- Impact bargaining all options; except status quo
- PreK program schedule all options; except status quo
- LABBB at High school all options; except status quo
- Crossing Guard schedules all options; except status quo
- LCE all options; except status quo
  - Availability of space
- Food Service all options; except status quo
- Extended Day all options; except status quo

- Reverses order of schools, staggering start times for tiered approach
- Achieves later start time at HS, minimal impact to MS start time
- Lowest cost alternative
  - No additional buses required
- 1hr 10min change to elementary start time
- Requires elementary students be at bus stops starting at 7am
- Athletic scheduling becomes compressed particularly late fall; early spring
  - Need to put lights on fields i.e. Lincoln Fields ~\$200-300k per field
- Recreation Department scheduling impacts; field/building availability for LPS, Recreation, and community organizations
- Elementary METCO routes starting early; may extend secondary route lengths (traffic)
- After school clubs/activities/jobs become compressed at HS level; increases available time for ES

- Reduced impact to elementary schools
- Achieves later start time at HS and MS
- Highest cost alternative
  - Approximately 55 buses needed \$4.8 million
- Athletic scheduling becomes compressed particularly late fall; early spring
  - Need to put lights on fields i.e. Lincoln Fields ~\$200-300k per field
- Recreation Department scheduling impacts; field/building availability for LPS, Recreation, and community organizations
- Increases benefit to elementary METCO routes; may extend secondary route lengths (traffic)
- After school clubs/activities/jobs become compressed at MS/HS level; increases available time for ES

- Reduced impact to elementary schools compared to Option 2: "The Flip"
- Achieves later start time at HS and MS
- Moderate cost alternative
  - Approximately 11 buses needed \$960k
- Requires that middle school and high school students ride the same bus
  - May have supervision impacts with buses moving from MS to HS in afternoon
- Athletic scheduling becomes compressed particularly late fall; early spring
  - Need to put lights on fields i.e. Lincoln Fields ~\$200-300k per field
- Recreation Department scheduling impacts; field/building availability for LPS, Recreation, and community organizations
- Increases benefit to elementary METCO routes; may extend secondary route lengths (traffic)
- After school clubs/activities/jobs become compressed at MS/HS level; increases available time for ES

  - No supervision impacts at HS in afternoon
- Athletic scheduling becomes compressed particularly late fall; early spring
  - Need to put lights on fields i.e. Lincoln Fields ~\$200-300k per field
- Recreation Department scheduling impacts; field/building availability for LPS, Recreation, and community organizations
- Increases benefit to elementary METCO routes; may extend secondary route lengths (traffic)
- After school clubs/activities/jobs become compressed at MS/HS level; increases available time for ES
